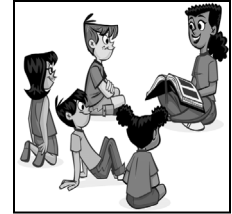

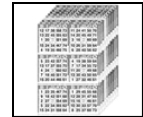

SIGAMOS AL BUEN PASTOR

El tono de alegría de los tres domingos pasados se ensombrece hoy. Las tres lecturas nos recuerdan el sufrimiento, la muerte y el pecado. Nosotros, igual que la audiencia de Pedro en la primera lectura, podemos preguntar, “¿Qué tenemos que hacer?” Y la respuesta es la misma: Tenemos que convertirnos. O, como Pedro dice en su primera carta, nos hemos extraviado como las ovejas perdidas y tenemos que regresar al pastor.

En el Evangelio de hoy Jesús se describe a sí mismo como el pastor y sabemos que fue una de las primeras imágenes de Cristo en la Iglesia de los apóstoles. El pasaje de hoy continúa el tema más sombrío de las dos primeras lecturas. El peligro acecha y las ovejas necesitan protección. Podrían seguir un guía falso, podrían ser robadas o destruidas. Primera lectura —	Los que creyeron fueron bautizados	(Hechos 2:14a,36-41).
Salmo —	El Señor es mi pastor, nada me falta	(Salmo 23 [22]).
Segunda lectura	Han vuelto al pastor y guardián de sus almas	(1 Pedro 2:20b-25).
Evangelio —	Yo soy la puerta para las ovejas	(Juan 10:1-10).

LA PALABRA DE DIOS HOY

Jesús, el Buen Pastor, nos dice que él llama a sus ovejas por nombre y que la respuesta de esas ovejas es seguirle. Al contrario de los primeros discípulos nosotros no tenemos el beneficio de escuchar al Señor Jesús llamándonos por nuestro nombre. ¿De veras? A través de los siglos, incontables hombres, mujeres y niños han respondido al llamado del Señor y han entregado su vida al servicio del Pueblo de Dios. ¿Cuántas veces no hemos escuchado la frase, “él o ella tiene vocación”?

No tenemos que buscar más allá de nuestra propia parroquia para encontrar las diferentes maneras en que el llamado del Señor se manifiesta. El Señor Jesús nos está llamando constantemente por medio de la celebración de la vida sacramental, a través de su palabra viva y por el ejemplo de aquellos que se han revestido de Cristo en el Bautismo. Hoy el Señor Jesús, el Buen Pastor, nos habla a cada uno de nosotros, las ovejas de su redil. Estemos atentos al llamado de seguirle como discípulos suyos.
